NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS

This Notice is being sent to stakeholders to correct a technical error in the length of time the prior comment periods allowed in Rulemaking Record 2010-0513-02S as well as correcting an error in showing a change made as a result of a comment received during one of the public comment periods. Specifically, the two 15-day comment periods held were, in fact, only 14 days. In an effort to allow stakeholders to comment during a full comment period timeframe and to see the changes made resulting from prior comments received, the Board is conducting a final 15-day comment period for submission of any comments or concerns by the public.

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board is providing notice of changes made to proposed regulation section 640 - 645. These changes are made in response to comments received during the original 45-day public comment period from November 6, 2009, through December 21, 2009; the first 15-day public comment period from February 3 – 17, 2010; and the second 15-day public comment period from March 15 – 29, 2010.

If you have any comments or concerns regarding the proposed changes, the Board will accept written comments between July 16 - 31, 2010. All written comments must be submitted to the Board no later than 5:00p.m. on July 31, 2010.
